ADC-Agency Agreement

To qualify for this service, an agency must be a member of The California Alliance of Child and Family Services. Non-Member agencies can qualify by special arrangement only and the fee for the service will be increased.

ADC requires that the agency have qualified adoption program leadership and supervision in place for the initial training. Due to our commitment to excellence, exemptions or exceptions will not satisfy this requirement.

CACFS Agencies

1. The Agency signs the Adoption Development Consultants (ADC) agreement and returns it with a check for three thousand dollars (\$3,000). The final three thousand dollars (\$3,000) will be paid prior to training by Lilliput, Make checks payable to: Daniel M. Marble and Associates, ADC

2. ADC submits Adoption Program Statement to the State of California (cc to agency)
3. Agency will be contacted to have the program statement explained so that agency can communicate with State.
4. When Adoption Program Statement clears the State, the agency will be notified and will submit required agency paperwork to CCL.
5. When close to license clearance from CCL, Daniel Marble will coordinate agency training which will be performed by Lilliput Children's Services. Agency pays final three thousand dollars (\$3000).
6. Following Lilliput training, Daniel Marble will coordinate the agency staff SAFE training which the agency will pay for separately and in addition to ADC fee.
7. ADC will arrange for a one year agency membership in the California Association of Adoption Agencies (CAAA) at no additional cost.
8. For the first year following licensure ADC will provide ongoing consultation through associate Jane Lewis, MSW at no additional cost.
9. ADC will continue a consulting relationship with the agency, after the first year, as requested by the agency and paid for at an hourly rate plus expenses.
